GENERAL GUIDANCE

ASSOCIATE (AIIAI)

Applicants seeking to join as an Associate of the Institute (AIIAI) are not required to have had any prior experience in the field of industrial accident investigation. This grade recognises those who are developing an interest in the process.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER (AMIIAI)

Applicants seeking to join as Associate Members (AMIIAI) should have had a degree of exposure to the investigative process over the past two years and be in possession of the Foundation and Management Certificates. Applicants who do not possess these certificates can briefly describe the work they do, their occupational qualifications and their accident investigation experience (if not sufficiently addressed elsewhere). This must be typed (two sides max) and attached to this form. There are no set requirements and each applicant is therefore considered on the case they present. The Institute values its Associate Members and assists genuine applicants to achieve this grade; we will contact you if any additional information or further clarification is needed.

MEMBER (MIIAI)

With few exceptions, applicants seeking election or transfer to the grade of Member (MIIAI) must be in possession of the IIAI Lead Accident Investigators' Certificate. In all cases, applicants must certify that they have been involved with the accident investigation process in some form or another for at least three years.
